### **ARTICLE I**

#### **Name and Territorial Jurisdiction**

**Section 1:** Name: The National Socialist American Labor Party” hereinafter referred to as “NSALP” or “the Party.”

**Section 2:** The territorial jurisdiction of this Political entity shall conform with the territorial limits of the United States of America while maintaining unique and special ties with kindred Folk all over the world.

## ARTICLE II

### Party Definition

**Section 1.** The Party follows the political thought and philosophy of Adolf Hitler and the NSDAP as outlined in "Mein Kampf". The Party recognizes that fundamental changes must be made to original National Socialist principles in order to bring National Socialist ideals and action into the Twenty-First Century. These changes will never fundamentally oppose traditional National Socialist orthodoxy.

**Section 2.** The NSALP is an Orthodox National Socialist party. The Party shall not commingle any other political ideology or philosophy or religious tenant in an effort to form a hybrid form of National Socialism.

**Section 3.** The Party shall work to bring about through legal and political means a Second American Revolution. This new dawn will result in the amending of Constitution of the United States so that it reflects the principles and eternal truths of American National Socialism for the benefit, protection, and advancement of the Aryan folk.

**Section 4.** The Party repudiates any and all criminal acts and acts of domestic terrorism. Any member that engages in such acts shall be expelled and such act not considered an act of the Party.

**Section 5.** The Party is prohibited from merging with any other entity or being governed by any other entity.

**Section 6.** The Party will take as its Standard the Blood Flag of the NSDAP. The Party Chairman is empowered to adopt additional Standards.

## ARTICLE III

### Objects

The objects of this association are political, fraternal, patriotic, historical and educational; to preserve and strengthen comradeship among its members; to assist worthy comrades; to perpetuate the memory and history of our dead, to foster true patriotism; to maintain and extend the institutions of American culture from the Aryan perspective; to improve our Folk through the installation of National Socialist principles for economics,

health care, housing, and family; and to preserve and defend the United States, from all her enemies whomsoever.

## ARTICLE IV

### Authority

**Section 1.** Authority: The supreme power of the NSALP shall be vested in the National Chairman of the National Socialist American Labor Party, and shall, at all times, be governed by the Party's policies and in the best interest of the American Folk. The Party Charter and By-Laws are written as a uniform guide of conduct for American National Socialists adopted by the Party through Party Chairman authorization.

**Section 2.** Subject to the provisions of the NSALP Charter and By-Laws, the governance of this Party shall be vested in a National Party Convention, National Party Senate and ultimately by the lawful orders of the National Party Chairman.

**Section 3.** The Party Chairman may promulgate Policies and regulations to safeguard the Party, its Assets, and its Members as he sees fit and or as circumstances may determine, including amendments to this Document.

**Section 4.** All Party Officers, Appointees Committees, and Special Committees in office or existence at the time of the approval and adoption of this Charter & By-Laws shall continue in office and exercise full authority, but in accordance with this Charter & By-Laws.

## ARTICLE V

### National Headquarters

**Section 1.** The National NSALP Party Headquarters shall be located in a City determined by the Party Chairman that best serves the Party's strategic objectives.

**Section 2.** All official Party orders and mandates emanating from National Headquarters shall be in writing and seal of the Party and shall be signed by the Chairman of the NSALP.

## Membership

**Section 1.** The NSALP (henceforth called “the Party” does not require membership dues or fees. An official application process for membership shall be promulgated by the Party Chairman.

**Section 2.** Only a Citizen of the United States of America may be a Party Member, a "permanent resident" is not considered a citizen.

**Section 3.** No member of the Party shall hold dual membership in any other Nationalist political entity.

**Section 4.** Only those of Aryan Heritage (European- Nordic -Anglo-Saxon) descent OR are classified as Aryan by the NSALP Racial Policy Statement.

**Section 5.** (a) The Party may conduct background investigations on applicants.

(b) The Party will NOT accept for membership those convicted of serious felonies, those convicted for crimes against persons, sexual crimes, crimes against children, crimes of moral turpitude, homosexuals or another issue that the Chairman feels will bring disrepute to the Party and National Socialism.

**Section 6.** Any Member of the Party who joins under false pretenses or who is later found to have provided false information in the application process shall be immediately expelled.

**Section 7.** The Chairman may delegate membership matters but will have final determination over all Membership issues and policies

**Section 8.** The Party maintains no separate women’s division. Women are encouraged to accept leadership roles within the Party.

**Section 9.** Applications for membership in Local Districts must be approved by the District Leader, or by the National Chairman of the NSALP Party Executive Office when no District exists where the applicant resides.

**Section 10.** All members should continue familiarize themselves with National Socialist political, economic, and social theory and practices. All Members should have the following texts:

**Section 11.** NSALP Members should also be prudent and not intermingle other political entities or philosophical teachings and writings with that of true National Socialism and the NSALP.

**Section 12.** Members must also commit to the NSALP Continuing Development Program, which include Seminars via Web Cam, Teleconference, and Convention/Party Congress.

**Section 13.** (a) NSALP Members who do not have High School equivalent degrees should enroll in their local Adult Education Facility so as to secure a General High School Diploma.

(b) The Party offers limited Scholarship assistance and believes that all National Socialists should be educated. The same goes for higher education.

(c) The Party encourages all Members to enroll in Colleges and University(s), especially Community Colleges, as this is an economical means to a higher education. It is critical that National Socialists be educated and well spoken as we enter the arena of politics and public debate. Your college experience is an excellent recruitment tool and platform to spread the National Socialist message.

**Section 14.** (a) Party members must conduct themselves with decorum, respect and civility.

(b) In all things, follow the National Socialist Party Code of Ethics and the NSALP Code of Conduct.

(c) A National Socialist represents the elite of our Folk. Crude and base behavior is not tolerated.

(d) Every NSALP Member represents not only the NSALP, but MOST IMPORTANTLY, National Socialism to the Community(ies) around that Member. Lewd and guttural activities will not be tolerated. Alcoholics, drug addicts, or participants of perverted

lifestyles are not representative of our Folk ideals and therefore are not recognized as National Socialists.

(e) Members will observe the strictest Code of Conduct with regard to behavior, language and above all Dress. As an example you should look to our founders in the NSDAP, never would they have attended “official” events in unpressed shirts, shorts, or otherwise sloppy attire unbecoming the high standards of National Socialism. National Socialism calls for the promotion of and the building of our culture and strong families, we cannot do this if our mere appearance frightens the very people from attending our events or our conduct, appearance and language so disgusts and offends those who would otherwise be our natural allies that they will never listen to us.

## ARTICLE VII

### National Party Governance and Administration

**Section 1.** (a) The Chairman will be assisted in running the Party by a Party Senate comprised of six (6) advisers, who will be appointed by the Chairman.

(b) The initial FIVE FOUNDERS shall occupy five of the first appointments until their death, resignation or removal by the Chairman after a period of 6 years. Thereafter, the Chairman shall appoint vacancies to the Party Senate who shall serve for terms of 6 years.

**Section 2.** The Party operates in accordance with the leadership principals established and documented within the NSDAP. The Chairman serves until death, resignation or is incapacitated.

**Section 3.** (a) The Chairman shall name his successor. In the event the Chairman’s office becomes vacant and a successor has not been named, the Party Senate shall meet in person, in-camera and shall name a Chairman.

(b) The Party Senate may appoint an interim Chairman until it can meet in person to formally name a permanent Chairman.

(c) The Party Senate must choose a Chairman via unanimous vote.

**Section 4.** (a) The Party will be organized along District and Regions as determined by the Chairman.



(b) State and Region Party Leaders will be appointed by the Chairman and will serve at the will of the Chairman.

**Section 5.** The Chairman may appoint any other Party Positions as necessary so as to provide for the professional advancement of the NSALP.

**Section 6.** Party assets, such as web sites, offices, etc, shall be held by the Chairman or designee(s).

**Section 7.** The District Leaders, as appointed to post by the Party Chairman, of the National Party Senate shall be not more than eighteen (18) in number and shall each appoint from the respective district a Party comrade to represent the District as hereinafter provided.

**Section 8.** The National Party Senate shall meet once each year in the city the Council may designate such meetings to be held at a time designated by the National Party Chairman.

**Section 9.** Copies of the minutes and any action taken by the National Party Senate or Party District or Party Region shall be sent to the National Party Chairman for review and approval within ten (10) calendar days after said Council meeting. Upon final approval by the National Party Chairman, copies of the minutes will be sent to each District Leader within thirty (30) days after said Council Meeting at which such action has been taken.

## ARTICLE VIII

### National Party Congress

**Section 1.** The composition of The National Congress shall be as prescribed in the NSALP Party Handbook.

**Section 2.** (a) Party delegate notification and registration must be approved by the Party Senate at the first meeting each year.

(b) The delegate and alternate strength of each Party Position within the Party shall be based upon one of each for every fifteen (15) members or fraction thereof in good standing thirty (30) days prior to Congress, and they shall be appointed in accordance with the provisions of the National By-Laws.



**Section 3.** Only those officers, delegates and alternates of the National Congress who are entitled to credentials and who have registered same at the Congress Headquarters shall be entitled to a vote or voice in the Congress.

**Section 4.** Party Congress officers and the time and place of the Congress shall be by National Party Senate recommendation to the Party Chairman.

**Section 5.** The minutes of the National Party Congress shall be taken by a competent reporter, and shall be published and forwarded to the Party Chairman for review and approval no later than ten (10) days subsequent to the close of the National Convention. After Party Chairman approval, the minutes will be distributed to all Party District Leaders not later than forty-five (45) days after the adjournment of said Convention.

**Section 6.** The National Party Congress shall be held each year at a date identified by the National Party Senate and approved by the Party Chairman.

**Section 7.** (a) The National Council of Party Administration shall be additionally, in preparation for the National Party Congress shall be:

1. To receive and consider bids for the annual Party Congress,
2. Establish the format and general procedures for the annual Congress
3. Determine whether one or more District Leaders shall host the Congress and prescribe the necessary operating or administrative rules for said Congress; or whether the National Party Headquarters shall operate the Convention or Conference.
4. A sum determined by the National Party Senate shall be included in the National budget for the expenses of the National Party Senate to conduct the National Congress - said sum to be reimbursed to the National Party from any funds realized through the operation of the Congress including donations.
5. "In the event of death, disability or refusal to act in these specific duties of any member composing the National Party Senate, the District Leader has the authority to immediately appoint a replacement".

## ARTICLE IX

### Committees

**Section 1.** All committees established prior to or during the Party National Congress shall be authorized through the National Party Senate and approved by the National Party Chairman.

1. Each committee will have a leader acting as the responsible party for the progress and success of that committee's goal(s).
2. Each committee leader will submit a monthly report to the National Party Senate leader, District leader and the Party Chairman.

## ARTICLE X

### Fund Raising

**Section 1.** Party fund raising is authorized through the National Party Senate and approved by the Party Chairman.

1. All funds are meticulously recorded and handled by Party members only.
2. Any funds are duly recorded with the Party and used for Party functions as authorized by Party leadership.

## ARTICLE XI

### Resolutions

**Section 1.** All Resolutions for Convention consideration shall be typewritten, in triplicate, and shall be in the hands of the National Party Senate at least fifteen (15) days prior to the convening of the Convention.

**Section 2.** No Resolution, other than those of condolence and appreciation, shall be considered by the Convention unless the provisions of Section 1 of this Article have been complied with.

**Section 3.** All Resolutions approved by the Convention, which do not conflict with the provisions of the National Convention and By-Laws and the Party Chairman of this National Socialist American Labor Party shall be considered mandated of action or administration by all District Leaders, provided, however, that the life of an enacted Resolution shall be considered as one year, or until the time of the following National Convention. Resolutions which are to be considered permanent must be enacted as amendments to the Party By-Laws.

## **Expenditures**

**Section 1.** All funds shall be expended and duly recorded only in the furtherance of the National Socialist American Labor Party, as determined by the National Chairman, or his designates, and according to state and federal law.

## **ARTICLE XIII**

### **Invested Party Funds**

**Section 1.** The National Party will maintain its own account under the direction of the Party Financial Officer, subject to sufferance by the Party Chairman. The Party Financial Officer will make periodic and annual financial reports to the Party Chairman and the National Party Senate.

**Section 2.** The District Party functionaries will maintain their own accounts under the direction of the District Party Financial Officer, subject to sufferance by the Party Chairman. The District Party Financial Officer will also oversee, review and/or audit the various state and local operations as the Financial Officer sees fit.

## **ARTICLE XIV**

### **Party Member Service Committee**

**Section 1.** The Party will endeavor to establish and maintain a committee with the charter to assist deserving Party members financially, spiritually, or physically when in the best interest of National Socialism and our Folk.

**Section 2.** The Party Member Service Committee will be assigned within each Party District and will be authorized to act only through Party District Leader and National Chairman authority.

**Section 3.** The Party Member Service Committee shall maintain a meticulous record of any and all benevolent activities and supply a monthly report to the National Party Senate and the National Chairman.

## **ARTICLE XV**

### **Amendments**

**Section 1.** These By-Laws may be amended by the National Convention by a Party Comrades written request to the National Party Senate provided no amendment shall be considered unless a copy of the same shall have been forwarded to said Senate at least fifteen (15) days prior to the convening of the Convention. No amendment shall be executed until the same has been approved by the Party Chairman.

## ARTICLE XVI

### District Party Officers

1. Leader – appointed by National Chairman
2. Deputy-Leader – appointed by District Leader
3. Communications Leader – appointed by the Chairman or District Leader at that level
4. Service Officer – serves for the common good of the Party personnel – appointed by District Leader
5. Education Officer – serves to continue the Party’s appreciation of National Socialism and it’s benefits to American society – appointed by District Leader
6. Financial Officer – serves as the Party’s accountant and ensures an accurate and full accounting of any and all Party funds that may be in the Party’s name – appointed by the District Leader.
7. Security Officer – serves to ensure that the Party meeting is conducted in an environment and in such a way as to afford appropriate discourse and exchange of ideas. The Security Officer may form a security committee to better serve the Party as directed by the District Leader. The Security Officer will be responsible for setting up the meeting area and ensuring all regalia is appropriately placed. The Security Officer will ensure that the meeting area is ready for occupation and will report to the District Leader of any anomalies. The Security Officer is appointed by the District Leader.
8. Adjutant – serves as recorder of Party meeting minutes and reports such – appointed by District Leader.

## ARTICLE XVII

### National/District Order of Meeting

#### Opening of Meeting

1. Ensure meeting area is appropriate and functional for the conduct of Party business. Party standards and books and/or manuals will be readily available prior to the beginning of the Party meeting
2. Party members gather and assume their stations.
3. The Party Security Officer ensures that all gathered are loyal Party members.
4. The meeting area is secured. Security is positioned to ensure effective conduct of the meeting.
5. Security Officer confirms meeting area is secured to the Party District/Local Leader.
6. Party members are requested to stand by the District/Local Leader.
7. The meeting is called to order by the District/Local Leader.
8. The Party anthem, Prussian Gloria, is played, if practical, and continues as the Party standard is installed.
9. The Party Standard is paraded into the meeting area as Prussian Gloria is played and installed at a place of honor.
10. The NSALP Oath of Allegiance is recited by Party members present.
11. Roll call is taken and recorded by the Party Adjutant.
12. Party members are requested to take their seats by the District Leader.
13. Party Adjutant reads the minutes from the prior meeting. Any Party member present may take exception to the minutes and they can be modified accordingly based on District Leader approval.
14. Party Adjutant identifies any "Old Business" from the last Party meeting that was not resolved. Party members can request to be recognized to offer resolutions to complete the old business at hand.
15. Party Adjutant records progress and/or closure of old business and any ensuing discussion.
16. Party Adjutant requests from Party members present if there is New Business to be considered at this meeting. Party members can request recognition to speak.
17. Party Adjutant records any new business and ensuing discussion.
18. Party Adjutant requests the financial report be read to Party members present by the Financial Officer.
19. Latest financial record is entered into the Party meeting minutes by the Party Adjutant. Any Party member present can be recognized and request clarification on any financial report given.
20. The District/Local Leader will request a report from the Party Service Officer for the "good of the Party".
21. Party Adjutant will enter the Service Officer's report and any ensuing discussion into the meeting minutes.
22. The District/Local Leader will request a report from the Party Education Officer. Guest speakers must have prior District/Local Leader and Security Officer approval.
23. Party Adjutant will enter the Education Officer's report and any ensuing discussion into the meeting minutes.

24. The District/Local Leader will request a report from the Party Security Officer.
25. Party Adjutant will enter the Security Officer's report and any ensuing discussion into the meeting minutes.
26. The District/Local Leader will request a report from the Party Vice-Leader. The topics covered by the Vice-Leader will be Party activities, political races, Party growth and movement toward a National Socialist state.
27. Party Adjutant will enter the Vice-Leader's report and any ensuing discussion into the meeting minutes.
28. The District/Local Leader will address the Party members gathered with any concerns or issues that require attention. The Leader will also ask if any Party member would like to address the meeting.
29. Final entries are made into the meeting minutes by the Party Adjutant.
30. The District/Local Leader announces the next meeting venue and then calls the current meeting adjourned.
31. Meeting area is returned to its original state with all Party documentation and regalia under security control.

## **ARTICLE XVIII**

### **Uniform of the Day**

1. Party member attire is dictated by the National Chairman or District Leader for the particular occasion and the appropriateness of the occasion.
2. Party members will adhere to strict codes of appearance and properly represent the high ideals of National Socialism.

## **ARTICLE XIX**

### **Party Functions (excluding District Meetings)**

1. Any Official Party function must be pre-approved by the District Leader if an internal function.
2. External or public functions must be pre-approved by the National Chairman.
3. Ensure that any public function has been drilled prior to the actual activity. The public display of National Socialism must be crisp and without error.
4. A Party member should record any official Party function through photographs and/or video.
5. A full report of the Party function must be generated and forwarded to the District Leader – upon review/approval will forward to the Party Chairman.



## ARTICLE XX

### Party Information Dissemination and Propaganda

1. Each local group leader or District Leader will assign a Party member to be the Propagandist.
2. Any Party posters will be placed in areas of legal advertisement.
3. Any Party informational pamphlet or poster must be of high standard. Outdated or weather-worn posters in no way beautifies the area.
4. Personal contact is a more effective form of leaflet distribution.
5. Information pamphlets, leaflets, or posters from high Party officials must be distributed at once.
6. Each Party member is an ambassador for the high ideals of National Socialism; the Local Propagandist is the primary contact point within a local area or district.
7. Coordinate placement and themes of Party leaflets, pamphlets and posters with the local Propaganda Leader.
  - a. Maintain a set theme for the target audience
  - b. The highest quality is required of Party propaganda

## ARTICLE XXI

### NSALP Public Meetings

1. The timing of meetings is determined by the cognizant District Leader.
2. A meeting hall of appropriate size and lay-out must be secured. The proposed meeting site will be thoroughly reviewed by the Party Security Officer and approved by the Local or District Leader.
3. Overlapping of the meeting date with other significant public meetings is to be avoided to afford the largest public turn out possible.
4. Appropriate advertisement of the meeting is to be thoroughly distributed in the community. Focus on the workers, farmers, students, and small businessmen.
5. Meeting advertisement should include the name of the speaker and the topic of the speech along with place and time.
6. The hall must be arranged and decorated to provide the attending citizen a clear picture of the inner strength and unity of the Party. The hall must be attended to down to the smallest detail.
7. Maintain an open center aisle in the hall.
8. The local Party members must inform the speaker of the concerns of the local populace well in advance of the speaking engagement.
9. The speaker's speech is the center of the meeting. The meeting follows this course:

- a. The meeting hall, especially the speaker's podium, has sufficient security yet does not interfere or detract with the overall appearance of the hall.
- b. Introduction: There should be musical accompaniment during the entrance of the flags.
- c. Entrance of the Flags: A flag entrance should occur only when there are a large number of flags. It's leadership must be military perfect, under the leadership of the senior ranking military veteran within the local Party. The political leader and his staff will have taken their seats before the entrance of the flags. The meeting greets the political leader by rising from their seat and giving the Aryan salute and greeting "Hail Victory". The playing of the NSALP Party anthem is started prior to the flags entering and will continue until the flags are secured and the last note of the anthem's current verse has completed.
- d. The Chairman opens the meeting: The chair is the political leader, or in his absence, the propaganda leader. The introduction of the speaker should be brief.
- e. The NSALP speaker speaks.
  - i. **NOTE: Any speaker at an NSALP function must be approved by District or National Party leadership.**
- f. Ensure that all Party members enthusiastically applaud as this will be contagious with the public in attendance. The speaker is not speaking to you but to the public in attendance – the Party members present are to set the example and applause.
- g. The former closing remarks by the chairman are now omitted. The speaker ends his remarks with the Aryan salute and "Hail Victory".
- h. The chair announces: "The meeting is concluded. The flags will now be carried out.
- i. The senior ranking military veteran within the local Party takes command of the procession as the flags are carried out.
- j. The speaker and political leaders leave the hall escorted by Party Security.
- k. The hall must be returned to it's original configuration ensuring that it is properly cleaned.

This Charter and By-Laws shall have immediate authority upon signing by the Party Chairman and shall supersede all prior governing documents of the Party.
